Day 1: Welcome to Los Angeles

Meet and greet at the hotel in Los Angeles; refreshments provided.

Night in Los Angeles, CA.

Day 2: Beverly Hills – Universal Studios Take a tour of the Walt Disney Concert Hall; explore the attractions of Hollywood and Beverly Hills; choose between individual exploration and a trip to Universal Studios.

Day 3: Anza Borrego – Desert Springs Explore Anza-Borrego Desert State Park. 2 Nights at resort in Desert Hot Springs

Day 4: Palm Springs – Jacinto Mountain, Visit Palm Springs, a tourist legend. Gondola ride up San Jacinto Mountain; visit to Indian Canyons.

Day 5: Joshua Tree – Twenty-nine Palms Hike, explore and photograph the unique landscape of Joshua Tree National Park, a tour highlight.

Night in Twenty-nine Palms.

Day 6: Mojave Desert – Mitchell Caverns – Las Vegas Experience the Mojave Desert; tour Mitchell Caverns. Then, drive on to Las Vegas for an evening on the strip. Night in Las Vegas. Day 7: Las Vegas - Red Rock Canyon In the morning, we will visit Red Rock Canyon State Park, a geological wonder full of desert life. Then, spend the rest of the day independently exploring Las Vegas. Second night in Las Vegas.

Day 8: Death Valley – Beatty Drive, walk, and photograph unique sights of Death Valley in springtime; stop at Furnace Creek Visitor Center. Night in Beatty, NV.

Day 9: Rhyolite Ghost Town - Devil's Corn Field - Lone Pine Visit Rhyolite Ghost Town; then, explore Death Valley sights, including the Devil's Corn Field.

Day 10: Alabama Hills – Fossil Falls – Kernville

Visit the base of Mt. Whitney and the strange rock formations of the Alabama Hills, where many Western movies have been filmed.

Night in Kernville, CA.

Day 11: Relax in Kernville, with many optional activities, including hiking, horse back rides and whitewater rafting.

Day 12: Antelope Valley – Getty Museum - Los Angeles

California Poppy Reserve. Then, visit the J. Paul Getty Museum or Venice Beach, depending on group interest. Farewell dinner in Los Angeles
