# Day 1: Las Vegas

6pm meet and greet in Las Vegas at a dinner location. Arrive early to enjoy world class entertainment & shopping.

# Day 2: Las Vegas - Valley of Fire - Bryce Canyon

Morning visit to Valley of Fire State Park with impressive sandstone formations and petroglyphs.

2 nights near Bryce Canyon

# Day 3: Bryce Canyon

Today's highlight is Bryce Canyon N.P. Hike along the rim and/or into the canyon; we'll help you choose your guided adventure.

Day 4: Hwy 12 -Kodachrome Park -Escalante Petrified Forest Park -Torrey Drive scenic Hwy 12; stop at Kodachrome State Park; later picnic and walk to petrified forest; afternoon hike to Lower Calf Creek Falls, with possible swim. Night in Torrey.

Day 5: Capitol Reef Park - Goblin Valley Park - Moab Hike in dry river canyon at Capitol Reef National Park, then picnic nearby. Walk among disney-like stone formations at Goblin Valley State Park. Stop at Sego Canyon to view rare rock art, then on to Moab, Utah 2 nights in Moab, Utah.

# Day 6: Arches National Park

Morning in Moab. Optional white water rafting on the Colorado River. Afternoon at Arches National Park with numerous walks to majestic arches.

Day 7: Canyonlands N.P. & Deadhorse Point Park – Durango
Explore "Islands in the Sky" area of
Canyonlands N.P., where the Green &
Colorado Rivers meet. Then on to Dead
Horse Point State Park, used as a natural
corral by cowboys in the 19<sup>th</sup> century.
Night in Durango, Colorado

# Day 8: Durango - Silverton

Visit old western towns Durango and Silverton. Optional 3-hour steam engine train tour.

# Day 9: Mesa Verde N.P.- Bluff

Mesa Verde National Park. Climb into ancient cliff dwellings of the ancestral Pueblo peoples on ranger-led tour. Night in Bluff / Blanding

Day 10: Valley of Gods - Gooseneck
Park - Monument Valley
Gooseneck State Park. Experience
Monument Valley--Navajo tribal park
and setting for popular westerns.
Optional night in hogan, hosted by
Navajo guides.

Day 11: Horseshoe Bend - Lake Powell - Antelope Canyon - Page Optional morning tour of Antelope Canyon, led by Navajo guide. A must for photographers. Optional boat tour on Lake Powell. 1 Night in Page

Day 12: Marble Canyon-Lees Ferry-Pipe Springs – Kanab Stop at Lees Ferry. Tour of Pipe Spring N.M., early Mormon fort. Coral Pink Sand Dunes. 2 nights in Kanab

# Day 13: Grand Canyon North Rim

Spend day absorbing extraordinary vistas at different stops along the rim. Time at visitor center. Possible ranger talks.

Day 14: Carmel Hwy-Zion N.P. – Las Vegas Explore singular beauty of Zion N.P. Afternoon return to Las Vegas.

Night in Las Vegas

Day 15: Death Valley N.P.- Sierra Nevada – Bishop Highlights today are Death Valley N.P.--the hottest spot in America-- and the Sierra Nevada range 1 night in Bishop Day 16: Laws- Ghost Town Bodie – Bridgeport Laws Depot with Railway Museum; visit Bodie Ghost Town.

1 night in Bridgeport.

Day 17: Mono Lake- Yosemite N.P. – Mariposa Otherworldly Mono Lake; Tioga Pass (if open) to Yosemite N.P. with its granite monoliths.

1 night in Mariposa.

Day 18: San Luis Reservoir- San Juan Bautista Mission-Steinbeck Center – Monterey Visit Steinbeck Museum; stroll Pacific beaches; explore Fisherman's Wharf. 2 nights near Monterey.

Day 19: Pebble Beach - 17 Mile Drive - Carmel Mission (Optional activities --whale watching or aquarium tour). Afternoon:17-mile drive; Carmel mission.

Day 20: Santa Cruz – San Francisco – Sausalito Head north to Santa Cruz and San Francisco. Views of Golden Gate; Sausalito farewell dinner.

**Day 21:** Journey home or continued travel on your town.
